

Daniel Z. Sui is a professor of geography and holder of Reta A. Haynes endowed chair in the College of Geosciences at Texas A&M University. He also holds adjunct professorship in epidemiology and biostatistics at Texas A&M System Health Science Center. Since 2004, Dr. Sui has been also been serving as assistant vice president for research and director for Geospatial Information Science and Technology (GIST) at Texas A&M. Dr. Sui is the current editor-in-chief for **GeoJournal** and the North America editor for the international journal of **Computers, Environment, and Urban Systems** (CEUS).

Sui held a B.S. (1986) and M.S. (1989) from Peking University and Ph.D. from University of Georgia (1993). His research areas cover geospatial information science and technology, urban sustainable development, environment, and public health issues in China and the U.S. He is author/co-author of 6 books and over 140 scientific publications. He is the winner of the Michael Breheny Prize in 2007, ORISE Fellow in 2004, and AT&T Faculty Fellow in 2000. Sui is also recipient of two outstanding teaching awards at Texas A&M University.
